COVID UPDATES

COVID-19 is still not over: As COVID-19 cases continue to rise at an alarming rate, the Ontario government, in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health and other health experts, is imposing a Province wide Shutdown. Additional restrictions will be put into place and reinforce that Ontarians should stay at home as much as possible to minimize transmission of the virus and prevent hospitals from becoming overwhelmed. The Province wide Shutdown went into effect as of Saturday, December 26, 2020, at 12:01 a.m.
