COMMUNITY FOOD DRIVE

The Community Support Team is organizing a food drive and donation of personal care packages from now until the end of February to support the needy and homeless. NCAC will be donating these items to Toronto Alliance Church for distribution in the Queen Street and Bathurst Street area. We welcome any non-perishable food items such as cookies, canned salmon, instant oatmeal, vegetarian soup and canned kidney beans. In addition, any personal hygiene items such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, dental floss, and socks are also needed. COVID UPDATES

COVID-19 is still not over: As COVID-19 cases continue to rise at an alarming rate, the Ontario government, in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health and other health experts, is imposing a Province wide Shutdown. Additional restrictions will be put into place and reinforce that Ontarians should stay at home as much as possible to minimize transmission of the virus and prevent hospitals from becoming overwhelmed.

On February 19, 2021, the Province announced extending the 'Stay-at-Home' order in Toronto and Peel region till March 8, 2021.
