As COVID-19 cases continue to surge, the Ontario government in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health and other health experts are reinforcing Ontarians to 'stay at home' as much as possible to minimize transmission of the virus and prevent hospitals from becoming overwhelmed.

On April 16, 2021, the Ontario government further extended a province wide 'Emergency and stay-athome Order' until May 20. This comes with new restrictions.
