NCAC RE-OPENING ROADMAP

With key public health indicators and province wide vaccination rate continuing to improve, Ontario is easing restrictions on in-person gathering. Elders Board is planning for reopening in September when our AV team and worship team are ready for hybrid worship services, when building facility and support teams can get ready, when more capacity is allowed and more congregants are vaccinated, enabling safe reopening and providing of both in person and online worship services. MISSION FUND 2021 – MID YEAR UPDATE

Praise the Lord! By the end of June 2021, we have raised \$51,955 for 2021 NCAC Mission Fund, achieving 41% of our annual fundraising target \$127,400.

With the surplus we carried from the previous years, we are able to send out 50% of this year support earlier this month to C&MA Global Advance Fund and other organizations and international workers supported on our Mission Budget.
