Praise God! Soran and his family arrived in Toronto on May 2. While staying at their friend's home temporarily, they will look for an apartment at least with 2 bedrooms to rent. If you know of any units for rent, please contact Elton Cheong, Michael Huynh or David Tong.

The family will also need some used furniture and daily necessities after they find a permanent place. Refugee ministry will come up with a list of items for brothers and sisters to consider. Please continue to pray for their adjustment in Toronto.

## PASTORAL SEARCH COMMITTEE

The Board of Elders has approved to expand the mandate of the Pastoral Search committee to search for a Chinese Ministry Pastor. This is to increase the flexibility to address the need of the pastoral leadership of the Chinese congregation until the Senior Pastor position is filled. ## 2024/2025 ELDERS NOMINATION COMMITTEE

## **MASK-FRIENDLY ANNOUNCEMENT WEF JAN 15, 2023**
