見證分享

高桂家蓉

我是高桂家蓉 (Silvana Ko)，來自香港。中學及大學都就讀基督教學校。直至畢業，由於家中沒有人信教，所以我一直沒有宗教信仰。

直至來到加拿大後，幾年前，我突然有病，双目不能清楚看東西。我很擔心，甚至哭了幾晚。

有一天早上，有一位男仕來探訪我，他是一位充滿愛心和關懷的基督徒大學生，他說與護士談及我，知道我的情況，並安慰我，說很快會好的。他送了一本小冊子給我，說是聖經的一部分。要我有空便看看。我說現在我的視力很差，根本無法閱讀。他說這是一本會發聲的小冊子，一按這裡便會開聲閱讀，而且內容全是平日常見到的「金句」。真的要感謝他！

不過，兩年後，我把這書轉送了給另一位視力很差的老人家。回家後，有信教的同事引導我在電台或電視台聽道理，及參加基約教會網上主日崇拜，小組研經班，還加入了小組團契，迦南年長團契，直到現在。

Testimonies

Silvana Ko

I am Silvana Ko, from Hong Kong. I attended Christian schools for both my secondary and university education. However, after graduation, since no one in my family believed in religion, I lived without any faith.

It wasn't until I came to Canada a few years ago that I suddenly became ill and lost the ability to see clearly. I was very worried and even cried for several nights.

One morning, a man came to visit me. He was a kind and caring Christian university student. He had spoken with a nurse about my condition, and upon learning of my situation, he comforted me, telling me that I would recover soon. He gave me a small booklet, saying it was part of the Bible and encouraged me to read it when I had time. I told him that my vision was so poor that I couldn't read. He then told me that it was a booklet with an audio function, and when I pressed a button, it would read the content aloud. The booklet contained familiar "golden verses" that one often hears. I was truly grateful to him!

However, two years later, I passed the booklet on to an elderly person who also had poor eyesight. After returning home, a believing colleague guided me to listen to teachings on the radio or television and to participate in the Sunday worship services and Bible study groups online from the

3月30日星期天，黃傳道和另外二位姊妹來護理院探望我。傳道領着我做了懺悔禱告。我一字一句地跟著祈禱。我決定跟隨耶穌。

我今年已82歲了。很想在有生之年，在靈性方面有個生根和立足處，所以很想信教受洗。

希望在這復活節，藉着洗禮，願神的愛，繼續在我的生命中發光，並能照亮其他人的生命。

New Covenant Alliance Church. I also joined an MSG small group, the Canaan Elderly Fellowship, where I continue to participate until now.

The church also arranged for Ms. Ann Sung (who is Wing Sung's wife) to read Bible teachings with me over the phone every Tuesday morning. We've been doing this for five years now, and her patient guidance has been very beneficial to me.

Since then, I have been reading the Bible regularly and have come to deeply love God's words. This has brought me peace and comfort. I now understand God's love and how Jesus died on the cross for us and rose again on the third day. Through His unconditional love, our sins are forgiven, and we can now be reconciled with God and become His children.

Whenever I feel uneasy, unwell, or worried about my husband's health, I pray, and God has heard my prayers.

On Sunday, March 30th, Pastor Wong and two sisters came to visit me in the care home. The pastor led me in a prayer of repentance, and I followed every word in the prayer. I have decided to follow Jesus.

I am 82 years old this year, and I wish to establish a spiritual foundation during my lifetime. Therefore, I really want to believe in God and be baptized.

I hope that through baptism this Easter, God's love will continue to shine in my life and illuminate the lives of others.

I came to Canada alone last March, while my husband and two children were still in Hong Kong. I met the New Covenant Alliance Church through a job-seeking seminar. This warmth made me feel incredibly supported, and I experienced the power of prayer.
