

Bill C-9 PETITION

You may have already learned about Bill C-9, which could potentially affect the future of freedom of religion in Canada.

We are broadcasting a short video produced by the Scarborough Chinese Alliance Church introducing Bill C-9, encouraging brothers and sisters to express their opinions to the government in different ways.

Here are three ways you can express your views for reference:

1. Collect signatures (provide name, address, email), then send them together to Member of Parliament Andrew Lawton, who has been actively opposing Bill C-9.
2. Individually write to the MP of your own electoral district.
3. Sign an online petition individually (provide name, email, phone number, postal code) and confirm via email. This petition will be submitted to the House of Commons by another MP, Marc Dalton, who also opposes Bill C-9, and the government is required to respond.
