2026 Sint Maarten Island Short-Term Mission Trip

Date: April 26 – May 7, 2026

NCAC, in collaboration with the Markham Chinese Alliance Church (MCAC), is organizing a short-term mission trip to Sint Maarten Island. Through shared resources and ministry with MCAC, to broaden our missionary horizons in Central and South America. We will build partnerships with local churches.

Mission Department will recruit 3 NCAC members, along with 6 believers from the MCAC, to participate in this short-term mission trip. The short-term mission team will lead worship services, evangelistic events, and discipleship training, and will conduct evangelistic visits with local believers, arrange and lead evangelistic activities and children's programs.

Qualifications (recruit total 3 members from NCAC):

1. We welcome born-again Christians who are NCAC members and are 18 years old or above.
2. Must attend all preparatory and training meetings.
3. Willing to adapt to and accept different cultural groups, and not hold racial prejudices.
4. Must have team spirit and obey the leader's arrangements.
5. After the short-term mission, willing to share their experiences in STM with the congregation to encourage brothers and sisters to participate in missionary work.
6. Language: Cantonese, Mandarin or English

Cost: Approximately \$1800 per person, including round-trip airfare, accommodation, and local transportation
