TESTIMONY OF MR. & MRS. YU

"Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." — Lamentations 3:22-23 (NIV)

A Seed Planted

Our journey began unexpectedly in 2002. While waiting for the subway, a woman named Mrs. Wong approached us and shared a gospel tract. That simple conversation led to an invitation to church. For a time, we were very active; we attended services regularly and even enrolled our grandchildren in summer camp. We saw God's hand when we moved houses and ended up becoming neighbors with Mrs. Wong. We didn't realize then that God was placing people in our lives who would later become our lifeline.

A Heart Divided

When Mrs. Yu suffered a fall at work, the church wrapped their arms around us. Later, in 2016, when Mr. Yu faced a major bypass surgery, the Lord provided support through Elaine, who helped us navigate the hospital system. In the fear of that moment, Mr. Yu made a promise to God: "If the surgery is a success, I will be baptized." The surgery was a success, but life became busy. We allowed other priorities to take over, and our commitment to God was pushed aside. We had forsaken our promise, but God never forsook us.

Finding Grace in the Valley

Recent years have brought heavy trials. Mr. Yu is battling lymphoma, and Mrs. Yu is navigating the challenges of Parkinson's disease. When she was hospitalized recently, we reached the "end of our road," and that is exactly where God stepped in. We witnessed miracle after miracle: The doctor refused to discharge Mrs. Yu until a transitional bed was secured, and against all odds, we were both admitted to the same Chinese Long-Term Care (LTC) home within two weeks—a process that usually takes years.

Our New Hope

Through these sufferings, our eyes have been opened. We have sought God's forgiveness for the times we turned away. He has shown us that He is our Rock. We no longer look at our future with despair, but with a hope that is everlasting. Today, we are being baptized to finally honor our commitment to the Lord. We give all glory to God, who is faithful and gracious, and who never gave up on us. Our prayer now is that our family will also come to know Jesus as their Savior.

All glory to the Lord!
