Update! – Alpha 2017

Praise God for His Work and Guidance: We had reached 38 guests and 8 kids in the first 4 Alpha nights, 7 of them are English speaking and 2 of them are Mandarin speaking. We had 25 guests/4 kids attended the first night (29/9); 21 guests/7 kids attended the second night (13/10), 18 guests/5 kids attended the third night (20/10) and 15 guests/3 kids attended the 4th night (27/10). Together with the Alpha Team and supporters, we had 52 people joined the 4th session's dinner and 4 small groups' discussion.

Praise the Lord for leading 23 and 5 brothers & sisters from the Chinese

& English Congregation completed one of the four Alpha Hosts/Co-hosts Trainings. Pray that God will use the 2 upcoming trainings on Tuesday evening (7/11) & Saturday early afternoon (11/11) to prepare the team for ministering to our guests through prayer ministry on the Alpha Day Camp (18/11). Pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to lead the Alpha

Team to serve and minister to our guests through prayers in faith and with loving hearts & actions. Please specially pray for the Alpha Day Camp where we had co-witnessed in past years that many had committed and re-committed their faith in this Day Retreat. So far we have 11 guests/3 kids and total 42 registered for the Day Camp in the first week of promotion. Pray that each individual will experience the love of God and respond to the call of the Holy Spirit to open the door and

invite Jesus into his/her life (or re-commit own life to Lord Jesus); and be transformed to a new person by the power of the Holy Spirit in this Alpha Day Retreat.
