Mission Ministry

We are thankful for your prayer and tangible support in Missions through actions and offering. The Mission Fund budget of 2017 is \$112,000. As of November 19, we have received \$82,288. There is still a gap of \$29,712 to fulfill our year-end faith target. Please continue to pray for the Mission work and respond to the needs in actions and offering.

Update! – Alpha 2017

To summarize: we had reached and served 52 guests and 10 kids in 2017 Alpha - 25 guests/4 kids, 21 guests/7 kids, 18 guests/5 kids, 15 guests/3 kids, 25 guests/6 kids, 19 guests/3 kids and 25 guests/7 kids attended the first 7 Alpha sessions, respectively. Pray that our guests will continue to attend the remaining 3 Alpha sessions and that they will attend church regularly after the 8/12 graduation session which will talk about the topic of "The Church". We are thankful to have 25 Alpha Team members complete one of the 3 training sessions (7/11, 14/11, 15/11) for the Day Camp Prayer Ministry. Please specially pray for the Personal Followup work of the 52 guests we met and served in this Alpha Course. Pray that our workers be equipped through upcoming Personal Followup Training sessions on 3/12, 5/12, 10/12 for serving our guests through personal interactions.
