Reflection for the Week and Prayer

Read: 1 Timothy 2:1

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.

Reflect:

Why is it important to pray for those in authority?

Pray:

- Pray for godly wisdom on leaders whose decisions and policies have the potential to impact the lives of millions of people – God to grant them wisdom, moral courage and a saving knowledge of Christ.
- Pray for those who are living in poverty, oppression, disease or natural disaster throughout the world.
- Pray for the persecuted church throughout Asia and Africa – believers to find comfort in their faith.
- Pray for churches today to bring the gospel of Christ to their neighbourhoods, towns and cities.
